Task order ordering procedures added under Modification No. P00001 under the subject contract are hereby revised to read:

ORDER PLACEMENT PROCEDURES (MULTIPLE AWARD)

The following clause defines the process by which (a) Fair Opportunity to be Considered will be afforded; (b) Task Orders will be competed; (c) Criteria for Award of a Task Order; and (d) Task Orders will be awarded.

(a) Fair Opportunity for Consideration-

(1) General. One or more task orders may be issued during the ordering period of this contract. The Contracting Officer's (CO) decision to issue a task order to a particular contract holder shall be based on the criteria stated below. In accordance with FAR 16.505(b), the CO will give each contract holder a "fair opportunity to be considered" for each order in excess of \$2,500 unless one of the conditions in 16.505(b)(2) applies. Procedures and selection factors to be considered for each task order providing for a "fair opportunity to be considered" are set forth in (a)(2) below.

(2) Procedures providing for a Fair Opportunity to be considered: The Government will provide all awardees a fair opportunity to be considered. This will be provided through the examination by the Government of existing information already in the possession of the Government or through request(s) for task order quotes. In the majority of cases, the Contracting Officer, in coordination with the COTR, will be able to select the appropriate awardee based on the data (including awarded CLIN pricing and the contractor's past performance on earlier orders under the contract) already available to the Government. In other cases, the Government may contact any or all of the contract holders for submission of quotes.

(b) Task Order Competition Procedures-

(1) Request for Quote (RFQ) Contents: When contractor submission of quotes is necessary, the Government will issue an RFQ. Each RFQ will include the following information:

- a) Date of the RFQ;
- b) Identification of required CLIN quantities;
- c) Pricing Format for submission of revised pricing;
- d) Past Performance Scoring Sheet (for information only);

You are hereby requested to provide a quotation (under the terms and conditions of Contract No. HSBP1006C01143) for the CLINs listed in Attachment 1, Pricing Format.

Please note:

1. The quotation must be sent by 4:00PM ET on the due date listed in Item 10 of the Standard Form 18. The address for US Mail deliveries is US Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection, Office of Procurement, Attn: T. Uberto, 1300 Pennsylvania Ave., NW, Room 1310, Washington, DC 20229. The address for FedEx (or other similar courier service or hand delivery) is US Department of Homeland Security, Customs and Border Protection, Office of Procurement, Attn: T. Uberto, 1331 Pennsylvania Ave., NW, National Place Building, Room 1310, Washington, DC 20004. No quotes delivered after the stated date and time of submittal will be considered.
2. Quoted pricing must be submitted in conformity with Attachment 1 - Pricing Format. Any and all alternate, additional or other extraneous pricing information (e.g., additional worksheets, columns, rows or totals, etc.) will be disregarded.
3. Quoted pricing may not exceed CLIN pricing under the referenced contract.
4. Separate pricing must be quoted for all CLINs (except 0003, Mainframe Class C and 0006, Server Class B-1) for the base period and for all option periods. Since demand currently exists (for CLINs 0001, 0002, 0004, 0005, 0007, 0008, 0009, 0010, 0011, 0012, 0013, and 0014) quotes will be ineligible for award unless offered pricing is included for all CLINs (except 0003 and 0006) for the base period and for all option periods.
5. Evaluated Prices. The Government will evaluate quotes for award purposes by multiplying the offered per unit monthly price by the estimated ordering quantities per CLIN to arrive at monthly extended prices. The total of monthly extended prices for all CLINs will then be multiplied by twelve to arrive at annual evaluated prices. This will be done for the base period, and for all option periods (if applicable). The total evaluated price will include annual evaluated prices for the base period plus all option periods.

6. Options (if applicable). The Government may determine that a quote is unacceptable if the option prices are significantly unbalanced or if no options are offered. Evaluation of options shall not obligate the Government to exercise the option(s). Failure to clearly state pricing for options in the quote will be treated as though no options are offered.

7. Selection will be based on the quoted price, and past performance on earlier orders under the contract, with price being the most significant consideration. Prior technical scoring will not receive further consideration and no separate technical evaluation will be conducted.

END INFORMATION AND SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

Generally, quotes responding to RFQ's will be due within seven (7) working days after the RFQ issue date.

(2) Task Order Evaluation/Selection Criteria. Upon receipt of the contractor's quote, the Government shall review the quote for completeness and acceptability. The determination of which contractor is awarded the task shall be based on a determination of the best value to the government. Price, and past performance on earlier orders under the contract, will be the only factors considered, with price being the most significant consideration in awarding tasks, consistent with FAR 16.505(b)(1)(ii) and (iii).

(3) Task orders will be issued such that one awardee will be performing tasks under the contract at any one time, for no less time than one month per order.

(4) Contractors may "No Bid" any RFQ.

(c) Award of Task Order-

Task orders will be placed by original signed orders within the effective ordering period of this contract.

Each task order will include the following information:

- 1) Date of the task order
- 2) Contract number and task order number
