1. The purpose of this administrative modification is to document an engineering change regarding the ARSS Radar and change the receipt date for the Cost Performance Report (CPR).
2. The Government and Boeing, through the Joint Change Control Board (JCCB), agreed to an engineering change regarding the implementation of a 4-amp resettable breaker in the Telephonics ARSS radar along with the complementing software in the Remote Tower Unit (RTU). Boeing presented a Rough Order Magnitude (ROM) of \$375,000. This effort is funded with funds already obligated on the task order. A full proposal, inclusive of both technical and cost information, will be submitted under the STO's extension proposal due May 8, 2009.
3. Boeing requested in a letter dated April 7, 2009 to have the Contract Data Requirement List (CDRL) H052, commonly known as the monthly CPR, changed from the 15th day of each month to the 22nd day of each month. The Government agrees with such request and CDRL H052 due date is changed to the 22nd of each month.
